In the event we do not have three scholarship recipients to be awarded for one of the scholarships, we will move the funds to the other to pay out a total of 6 (or as many as qualified if less) scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year.

Any applications received in government envelopes will automatically be disqualified. The scholarship winners will be announced during the Opening Session of the 2023 AIM-IRS Annual Business Meeting & Training Seminar on August 2nd.

The scholarship recipients will receive email notification within ten business days from the ending date of the Annual Business Meeting. The check for the scholarship will be made payable to the scholarship recipient's college/university and a letter provided from AIM-IRS. A copy of the letter will also be provided to the scholarship recipient. If the scholarship recipient has paid their tuition/books in full, we will request a copy of the receipt and write a check directly to the recipient for reimbursement.
